- 1638 CA. San Francisco.** Bradley & Rulofson. **\$1 in Payment for Photographs of Bearer.** A great topical note and a mimic of the National Gold Banknotes in circulation in 1874. The back is light brown/gold with the gold medal awarded them in Philadelphia that year. A sharp example. **Choice Fine plus.**

- 1639 NY. New York.** Bath Hotel Company, Seaside. **\$10 or One Share.** A small share certificate which served as an ad note as well. Superb vignette of the hotel at top. Fully issued and dated 1853. **Choice EF.**  
 (\$150-300)

- 1640 NY. New York.** Bath Hotel Company, Seaside. Company check, printed on blue paper with vignette as the last. Payable at the Ocean Bank of the City of New York. Unissued. **AU.** A superior unissued check by all means.

- 1641 Classic, Early and Engraved New York City Ad Notes.** [3] (\$125-250)

1) Drakes Plantation Bitters/Plantation Bank. **100.** Plantation scene. Snyder. Green back. Soft with back soiling, **About VG.** 2) Lyon's Celebrated Kathairon/Kathairon Bank. **50.** Alchemist at work (actually looks like Nostradamus reading *Vanity Fair* or something). **Fine,** trimmed in a bit at the top left. 3) Mexican Mustang Liniment/Mustang Bank. **50.** Volcano explodes! Mustang hunt lower right. Some stains. **Good to VG.**

- 1642 WI. Ripon.** J. M. Derees & Co. **3.** A mimic note of a federal legal tender in green and red. They were dealers in "Pure Drugs, Medicines, Books, Stationary...". A desirable location for this type of ad note. **AU.**  
 (\$100-200)

- 1643 Eastern Ad Note Mimic \$3 Bills.** [3] (\$125-250)

1) **MA. Boston.** J. Pitman's, Boot and Shoe Maker/Pitman's Old Curiosity Shop. **3.** Green and red. Back with long text in center, "X" style. **VF.** A nice "double" ad note. 2) **NJ. Bridgeton.** A. Johnson, Millinery. **3.** Similar to last, back with shorter ad. Minor splits in the mostly wide margins. **AU.** 3) **NY. Elmira.** J.M. Robinson & Sons, Furniture. **3.** Similar to last. Wide margins. **EF plus.** Nice trio.

- 1644 Midwestern Ad Note Mimic \$3 Bills.** [3] (\$100-200)

1) **IL. Chicago.** E.H. Stein, City of Paris. **3.** Dec. 1, 1868. 83 Clark Street. Small hole, glue on the back, else **Fine.** 2) **Sycamore.** Warren & Lott, Jewelers. **3.** "X" back with text at the bottom: "A nimble sixpence beats a slow shilling". **EF.** 3) **IA. Pella.** Dawley & Carson, Jewelers. **3.** Style as last, "X" back. A chunk off the left, a taped tear, but it looks **EF.**

- 1645 Ad Notes, Political Notes, Coupons and Others, A Few Scarce.** [11] (\$100-200)

Eclectic group that should be seen. Includes: \$1 Newspaper "Good For" scrip, Diamond Point Pen and Case ad note, Taft Republican Clearing Scrip (2), three ad notes on CSA mimic faces, a text ad, a genuine \$20 T-67 note, a pair of Brink's coupons (stained), Morse ad on NH scrip, and a Southern Orphan Association certificate. Average **VF.**

## College Currency



- 1646 MN. Rochester.** Hurd & Belknap's Commercial College. **\$20.** (Unlisted in Schingoethe). The imprint is Rochester, MN, with the back being green. The face is very faded with some stains. **VF.**

- 1647 New York, A Bryant and Stratton Green Tinted Pair.** [2] (\$125-250)

1) Bryant, Stratton & Co.'s International College Bank. **\$5.** Green tint and back by Hatch. Horses at the right. Issued. Aged, rough at the lower right. **About Fine.** 2) Same series. **\$1000.** Green tint by Hatch. Indian on horseback, left. Issued. **Fine.**

- 1648 Poughkeepsie, NY, Eastman Business College Small Denomination Notes.** 1-5) **1, 5, 10, 25, 50 cents.** Gold backs, red protectors. The third is **EF,** the others **AU to Unc.** 6) **10 cents.** Gold back. The red protector is different. **Unc.** [6] (\$100-200)

**1649 Scarcer Eastman Business College Small Denomination Notes.** [4] (\$100-200)

1) **3 cents.** Plain back. Man facing center with red "3". **Unc.** 2-3) **3, 5 cents.** "Fractional Currency" series. Green backs. Both **Unc.**, a large pinhole in the second. 4) **50 cents.** All red with Washington right. Uniface. **AU**, a few small holes.

**1650 Full Size Eastman College Bank Notes of Poughkeepsie, NY.** [2] (\$100-200)

1) Eastman College Bank of Eastmans National Business College. **\$5.** Red titles in black texts. Uniface. Eagle left, girl lower right. Corner shaved, but **VF**. 2) Same face style, different series. **\$50.** Green tint and ornate green back with miners. Stamped in red "SPECIMEN" etc. Some aging, but **Fine.** The second is quite scarce.

**1651 Syracuse, Ames' Business College Notes from Different Series.** [2] (\$200-300)

1) Ames' Business College Bank. **\$50.** (Sch. NY-2550-50). Bridge, Sage & Sons. Uniface. Unissued. **Unc.** 2) **\$20.** (NY-2575-20.A). Green protector and back, Sage & Sons. Issued. **EF.** A nice pair.

**1652 WI. Janesville. College Bank. Counter for Five Cents.** (Schingoethe WI-225-05). Simple design with red "5"

protectors. **Choice AU.** The first we have seen or handled. (\$250-500)

**1653 WI. Milwaukee. Spencerian Business College. \$50.** Overprint on Union College Bank note. Not in Schingoethe, but like WI-260. **Choice VF.**

(\$150-250)

**1654 College Currency Trio.** [3] (\$125-175)

1) **CT.** New London Business College. **\$10.** (Sch. CT-400-10). Red "10". Unissued. **EF.** 2) **OH.** *Cincinnati.* Nelson's College Currency, First International Bank. **\$10.** (Sch. OH-180-10). **VF plus.** 3) **PA.** *Kingston.* Wyoming College Bank. **\$5.** (Sch. PA-300-5A). Red "5". Unissued, a split and with some aging. **Fine plus.**

**1655 Fractional Mimic "Maverick" Note.** State of Improvement. **10¢.** A nice maverick college note, and a great mimic of a Fourth Issue fractional. Green back. **VG.** (\$100-150)**1656 Canada. Toronto, O.C.W. British American Commercial College Bank. \$100.** (ON-650-150). A beautiful type with a gold tint on the face and a green back. **Choice AU.** (\$150-250)**1657 College Currency Mavericks, A Nice Starter Collection.** [12] (\$125-250)

1-3) National School Bank. **25 cents, \$2, \$5.** Unissued. Green and uniface. Burn marks on the last two. Otherwise **VF.** 4-6) Budget Systems of Bookkeeping. **50 cents, \$2, \$500.** Gray with "College Currency" at center. All **VF.** 7) Merchants Bank Bookkeepers, Office. **\$5.** Violet/green. **Fine.** 8) 20th Century Book-Keeping and Office Practice. **\$5.** Gold/green. **EF.** 9-12) Business Practice Sets. **50 cents, \$20, \$50, \$100.** Yellow paper, brown printing. **AU.**

This long awaited volume features close to 1,000 different examples, with prices, rarity ratings, and hundreds of illustrations. These bank note "look alikes" are not found in Haxby's four volume encyclopedia work on obsolete bank notes, and they are not found in any of the state books on obsoletes. Early North American Advertising Notes is more than just a book for collectors. It chronicles one of the most interesting and entertaining advertising mediums ever invented. The beautiful graphics are a virtual art form. Many of the notes employ prose and poetry that is effective, persuasive, and entertaining. In short, this is a book that will be enjoyed by anyone who can appreciate the unbridled entrepreneurial spirit of American advertising.
