An interesting group, with scarce items, but lesser condition. Includes Crosby Opera House certificate (splits), City of East St. Louis \$1 and \$5 1878 scrips, West Aurora, IL "Doty" scrip (5, 25, 50 cents, all issued, but average **Good**), A City of Lafayette, IN 15 cents scrip with fire engine vignette, Davenport, IA 10 cents scrip (vignetted type), MI Duncan scrip 5 and 10 cents (issued, but only **Good plus**), a B.C. Hoyt 20 cents remainder note (**AU**), Treasurer of the City of St. Paul 10 cents and Ohio coupon for Amundsen (certainly a Norwegian!). Some slightly damaged items, but most are intact.
